Presentation of the Climate Change Travelling Exhibition



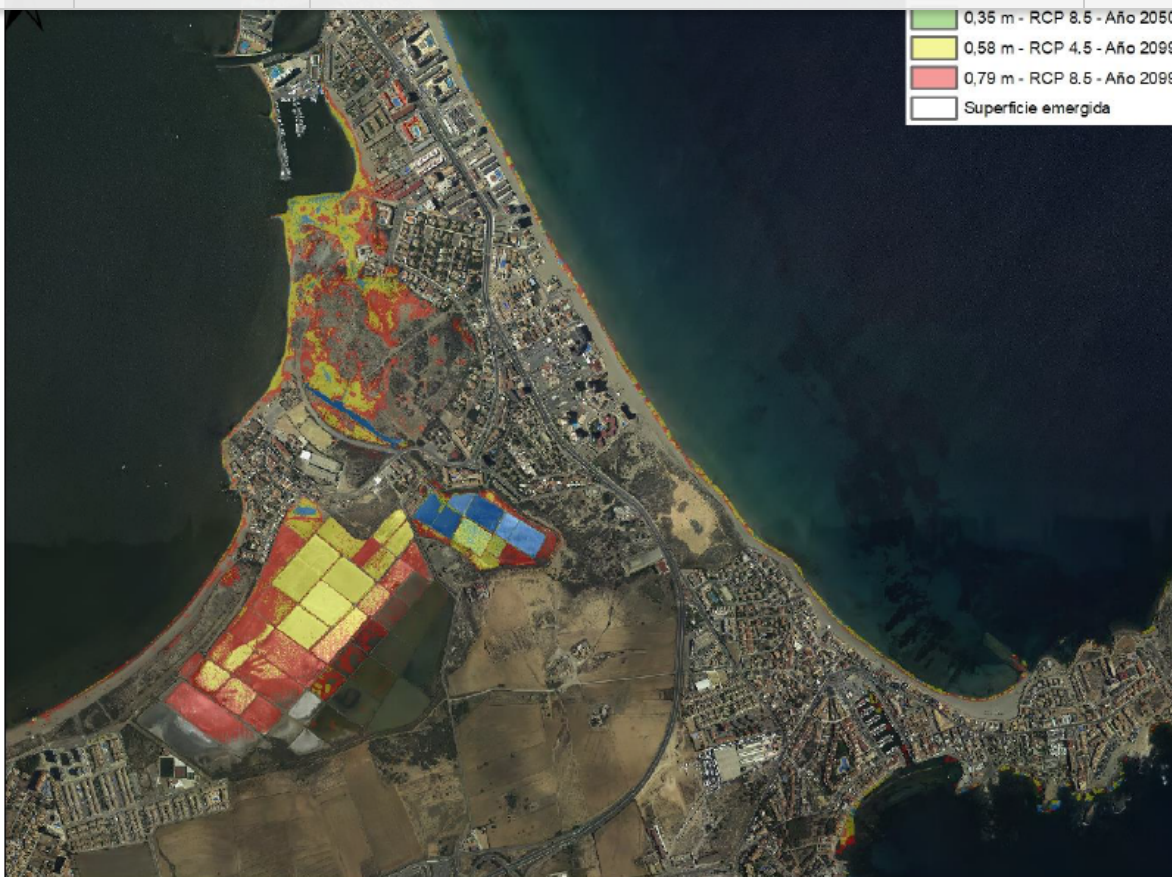

According to a research published by the scientific journal Nature Communications, 200 million people in the world will be affected by sea level rise in 2100.

Spain will be highly affected by the sea level rise. Specifically, the Service for the Promotion of the Environment and Climate Change of the Region of Murcia, a beneficiary of the Life Adaptate project, has developed a study of the areas that will be affected the most in the municipalities of Águilas, Lorca and Cartagena.
